#### **BAPTISMS:**

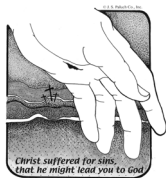
Baptisms are celebrated the 1st and 3rd Sundays of each month. Parents are required to attend two preparation meetings. Please call the Parish Office for an appointment.

6th Sunday of Easter

Dear Parish Family:



As we celebrate the Sixth Sunday of Easter, we hear in our First Reading that Philip went to Samaria to preach the Gospel. If we remember, Samaritans were met with disdain by the Jews as a mixed race of Israelite descendants and foreigners living in the region. This "mixed bag" of people accepted the Word of God and were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus, receiving the outpouring of the Holy Spirit in subsequent visits by Peter and John.

Our Second Reading offers a profound and succinct instruction for all disciples. With our hearts set on Christ, we must be ready to witness to our hope in him, with gentleness and reverence. In doing so, we may be maligned but it is better to suffer for doing good rather than for doing evil.

Our Gospel reading presents us with two key, interrelated thoughts: disciples who love Jesus will keep his commandments. Observation of the teachings of Jesus is the sign of love for him, and those who love Christ will be loved by the Father. Secondly, Jesus will remain with the disciples through the Advocate, the Spirit of truth whom the world cannot see, but who remains with and within his disciples.

My brothers and sisters in Christ, as we prepare to celebrate the Ascension of the Lord on Thursday, our readings remind us that Jesus has not left us alone. As the Gospel passage so beautifully says; "I will not leave you orphans, I will come to you." Sometimes that thought is hard to remember when we feel alone or forgotten but with our hearts set on Christ, we are assured that God loves us and gives us the Holy Spirit to guide us, to be our advocate. Let's never forget that promise of love and commitment from our heavenly Father and his son, our savior.

We congratulate our 15 students who received the Sacrament of Confirmation on Saturday by Bishop Andrzej Zglejszewski. May the Holy Spirit continue to be an important advocate in their lives.
