From Fr. Peter's Desk Third Sunday of Easter

Dear Parish Family:

In our First Reading, we hear Peter saying “we are witnesses,” to the crowds, referring to the Risen Lord. We heard Him preach repentance for the forgiveness of sins. We know He died for us on the cross and we have seen Him glorified by our God. We give witness by keeping His commandments.

We hear Luke, in today's Gospel, narrating one of the Risen Lord's appearances to the disciples, in which he calls them witnesses to His resurrection. Assured of His continuing presence, we too are able to sing “Lord, let your face shine on us.”

My brothers and sisters in Christ, during the Easter season, we hear how the disciples encounter the Risen Christ at different times and in different ways, all the while trying to understand the meaning of the Resurrection. We too must contemplate the implications of the Resurrection and consider how we see the Risen Lord in our lives.

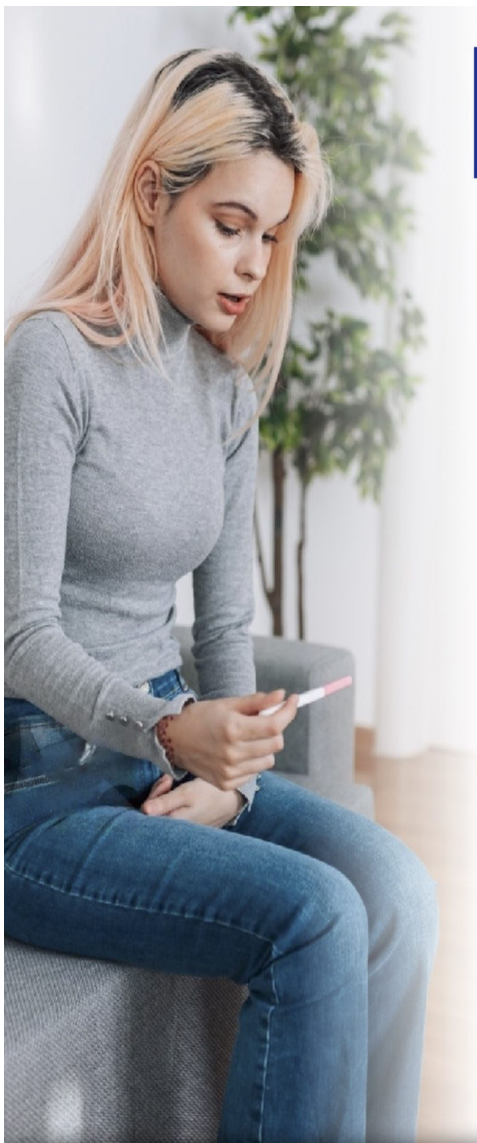
