Dear Parish Family:

In our First Reading, Wisdom meditates on her presence at the creation of the universe, as a joyful craftsman who plays alongside God while the Lord makes out the vault of the sky and fixes the earth on its foundation. Wisdom finds the most delight in the human race, those living beings created to mirror the Triune God’s goodness and self-giving love.

For St. Paul, it is the Holy Spirit who pours the love of God, Father and Son, into our hearts. For Paul, the “grace in which we stand” is the gift of access to God through faith in Christ. We learn in the Gospel that what the Father has, the Son also has, and what the Son has, the Spirit takes and declares to us.

Jesus’ words in today’s Gospel reveal the unity of the Trinity: The Father, Son and Spirit continually sharing everything with one another, in a loving union sometimes referred to as a dance.

My brothers and sisters in Christ, through our baptism, we are invited to enter into this loving relationship of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, which is our hope of salvation. Let us always thank God for his gift of the Holy Spirit and of hope.




