**From Fr. Peter’s Desk  
Pentecost Sunday**

Dear Parish Family:

In our First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles, Jesus’ promise is fulfilled as the Spirit arrives in wind and fire and gives the disciples the ability to proclaim the Gospel in the languages of all the nations. The disciples begin their commissioned task as witnesses to the Good News, as Jesus promised, beginning in Jerusalem and going from there to the ends of the earth.

Paul, in our Second Reading, describes the “spirit of adoption” that brings us into God’s household as children and even as joint heirs with the Son. To claim our inheritances, we follow Christ’s pattern through death to resurrection.

Our Gospel reading presents the promise of the Spirit. Jesus reassures His followers that they will not be left alone after His death, resurrection, and ascension into heaven. Jesus tells them that He will ask Father to send them an Advocate, the Spirit will remind the disciples of Jesus’ teachings. Through the Spirit’s presence, the disciples will be protected and empowered as they continue Jesus’ work.

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, the world has awaited this moment since its creation: the birth of the Church, a singular people whose work is to continue the work of Christ in the world. How do we walk in the footsteps of Jesus? We follow Christ by sharing his love and peace, an often-difficult mission. But we have been given the Holy Spirit, the paraclete, to guide us. Let us continue to pray for the wisdom and guidance of the Holy Spirit as we walk alongside Jesus in our mission of love.


