**From Fr. Peter's Desk**  
**30th Sunday In Ordinary Time**

Dear Parish Family:

In our First Reading from Sirach, we hear of a small tension between two truths. On the one hand, God does not play favorites, he welcomes home anyone who turns to Him. At the same time, God is especially inclined to protect the vulnerable and the oppressed. These two groups are so closely associated that they sometimes even seem to be the same.

In the Second Reading, Paul meditates on the end of his life and a race well run. He thinks of the reward he will receive, but unlike the Pharisee, he does not boast of his achievements or look down on others. God's appearance is the only award he awaits.

Our Gospel reading tells of the tax collector humbling himself before God, asking only for mercy. The Pharisee represents the opposite: a proud man who cannot see his need for God's help and despises people like the tax collector. He does not ask for mercy, so God does not give it!

My brothers and sisters in Christ, it's amusing to see the Pharisee presenting God with his moral resume, as if God is not aware already of our every action and thought. Worse than that is his arrogance, as shown in his contempt for his brother in faith, the tax collector. This Gospel make us pause and ask how often do we sit at Mass and view members of our faith family with judgment or even scorn? Better for us to take the measure of our sinfulness and avoid a preoccupation with anyone else's. A good starting point is to read Matthew 5:3-12 for a list of qualities Jesus says are required of a child of God.
