**From Fr. Peter’s Desk  
Easter Sunday**

Dear Parish Family:

In our First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles, Peter speaks of being a witness. “We are witnesses of all that He did . . . witnesses chosen by God in advance,” commissioned to testify. The prophets, too, “bear witness.” To witness is not simply to see. It is to give reliable testimony. At every Sunday Mass, we too give witness by reciting the Nicene Creed. In reciting the Creed, we give witness to the risen Christ.

St. Paul, in our Second Reading, tells the Colossians that “you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.” Paul would say that in baptism we already gained admittance to the next world, where we are “hidden with Christ.” Since we are joined with Christ, we are called to live as Christ calls us to live, seeing Him in our neighbor and serving those who are the best of our brothers and sisters.

On such a joyful day, it is startling that the Gospel reading emphasizes confusion. Resurrection cracks open the limits of what we thought possible. Even for those who have hoped in the resurrection, the evidence of life beyond death is so unexpected and shocking that other explanations compete for belief. Mary’s encounter with the risen Christ prompts recognition, understanding and witnessing.

My brothers and sisters in Christ, the empty tomb is a sign of hope and new life. It tells us Jesus defeated death. Fresh air fills the tombs of our hearts where sin once decayed our souls. Jesus is risen! Alleluia!

On behalf of Fr. Manuel and our staff, I wish to each of you a very Blessed and Happy Easter.

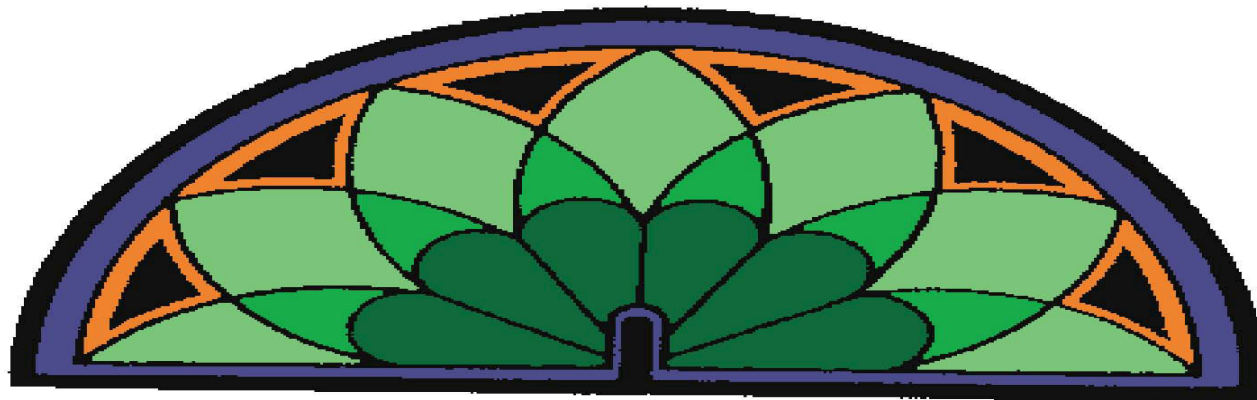

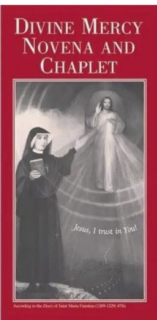
