**From Fr. Peter's Desk**  
**Fifth Sunday of Lent**

Dear Parish Family:

Ezekiel's vision in the valley of dry bones, of which we hear in our First Reading of today, concludes with a promise for a people that have been conquered, scattered, and beaten down. God promises to add sinew to bone, reassemble the scattered and shattered people and breathe into them so they can stand on their feet once more. This gift of divine spirit will bring life in place of exile and death.

Death is the subject of each of today's readings. St. Paul, in his letter to the Romans, speaks of life "in the flesh," a kind of spiritual death. God brings new life: sending us the Spirit, who gives life to our moral bodies.

In our Gospel reading, Jesus suffers grief and loss at the death of a friend. God's power over life and death led to a hope that God might one day restore to life all those who have died. Martha confessed this hope in naming her belief "in the resurrection on the last day".

My brothers and sisters in Christ, Jesus tells us as he told Martha, "I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die." He asks us, as He asked Martha, "Do you believe this?" Martha was asked this question before Jesus raised her brother Lazarus from the dead. She was asked to believe before witnessing the miracle. We are asked to do the same. Let us pray for the faith of Martha, to believe that we will be born to eternal life upon our deaths. This is the gift from God that we celebrate in a few weeks!
