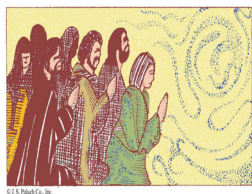
Parishioners arrangements must be made at least six months prior to the ceremony and before arranging the social plans.

**Second Sunday of Easter**  
**Divine Mercy Sunday**

Dear Parish Family:

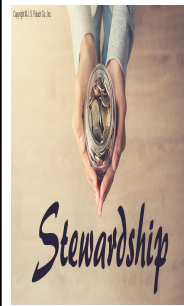
In our First Reading, Acts 2 describes a model of economic and social life that honors community and ensures that the needs of all in the community are met. This model of life together has its grounding in the teachings of and about Jesus, that were handed on to the early Church through the apostles.

Our Second Reading from 1 Peter celebrates Christ's resurrection and our baptism (new birth) as acts of divine mercy that help pave the way for our faith in love of Jesus Christ.

Our Gospel reading recalls the events of the evening of that first day of the week when Jesus appears to the disciples, who were locked in a room for fear of the Jews. Even though the disciples abandoned Him, the risen Christ sought out the disciples. Jesus pardons and restores them. He extended to His disciple's peace and a mission of forgiveness.

My brothers and sisters in Christ, to heal Thomas, Jesus invited him to touch his wounds. Through the wounds of Christ, Thomas was healed and received the peace of the risen Lord. How might we also be healed? Allow the Lord to come upon you and hear Him say, "Peace be with you". Allow His glorified Body and Blood to heal you when you receive communion at Mass. This Easter season, allow the Lord to enter your brokenness and heal your wounds. Happy Easter!

The memorials are as follows:

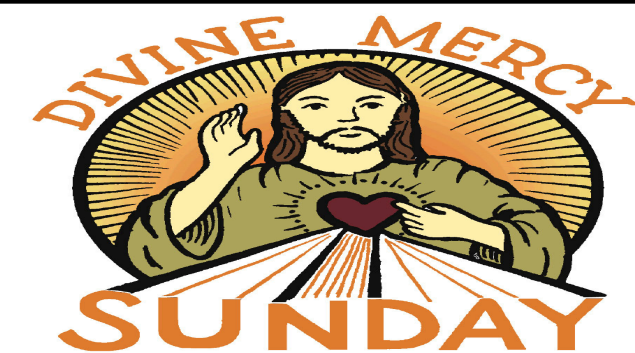
**Bread and Wine:** The donation to sponsor the Bread and Wine is either \$25.00 for a week or \$100.00 for the month

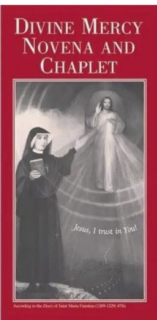
