**From Fr. Peter's Desk**  
**Pentecost Sunday**

Dear Parish Family:

Pentecost is the fiftieth day of Easter, the culmination of the Church's celebration of her Lord's resurrection. It is the day that the risen Christ poured out the Holy Spirit upon the Church. We hear, in our First Reading, the description of the coming of the Spirit, which enables the Church to proclaim her Lord's resurrection with words that all can understand, in the imagery of wind and fire. The powerful Spirit of the risen Christ empowers the tiny community of believers that once hid behind locked doors to do what it could not do and was afraid to do before: to proclaim the resurrection.

In his letter to the Corinthians, St. Paul teaches that it is the Spirit who enables us to confess that Jesus is the Lord of the Church and of our lives. It is the Spirit who gives every member of the Church gifts for the building up of the Body of Christ that is the Church.

Our Gospel highlights the intimate relationship between the giving of the Spirit and the forgiveness of sins. The risen Christ breathes the Spirit upon His disciples, and He assures them that those whose sins they forgive are forgiven, through the power of the Spirit.

My brothers and sisters in Christ, on Pentecost, we celebrate the birth of the Church-new life coming into being with the breath of the Holy Spirit. When we can hear or see matters of faith in our own contexts, we can identify more clearly the gifts of the Spirit at work. We then become more aware that there are many gifts and ways to serve. May we hear the Holy Spirit inside each of our hearts and spread the love of the triune God to all! Happy Pentecost.
